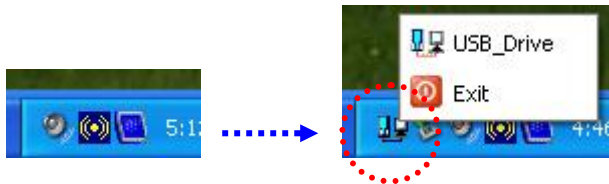

The Utility Provides USB Disk to partition and personal privacy areas for user.

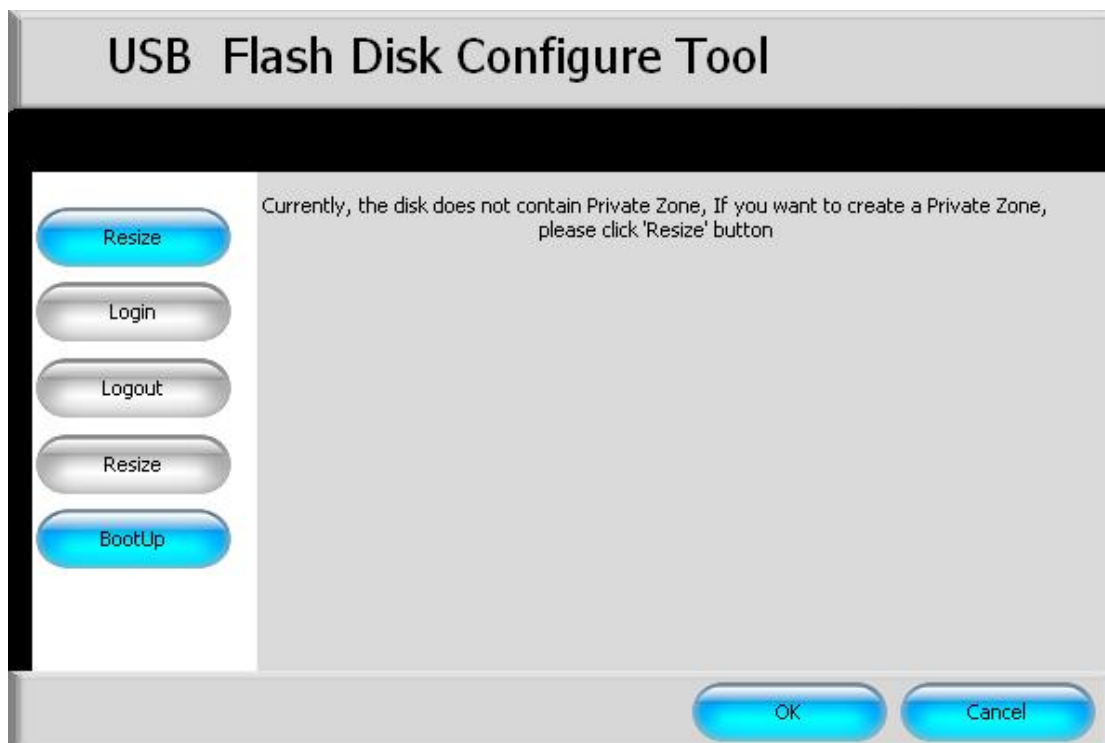
Installation:

3. You can find the icon of user program.



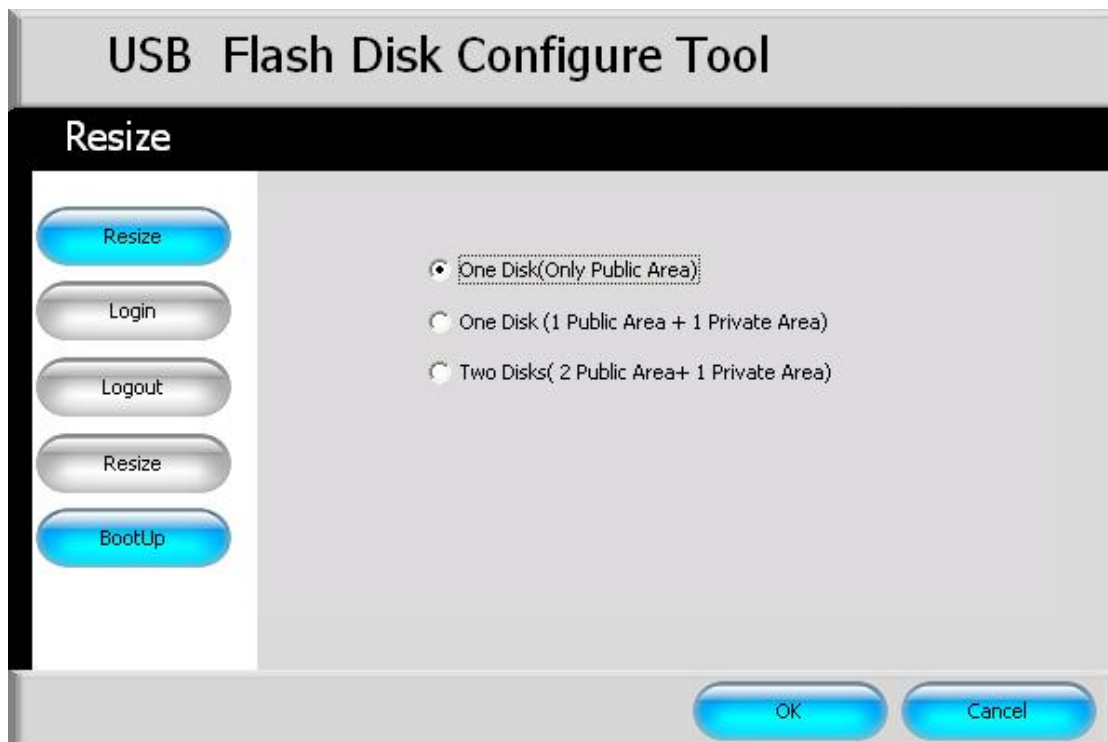

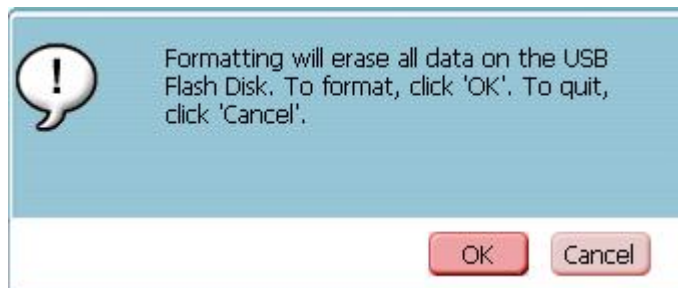

1.1 One Disk (Only Public Area)

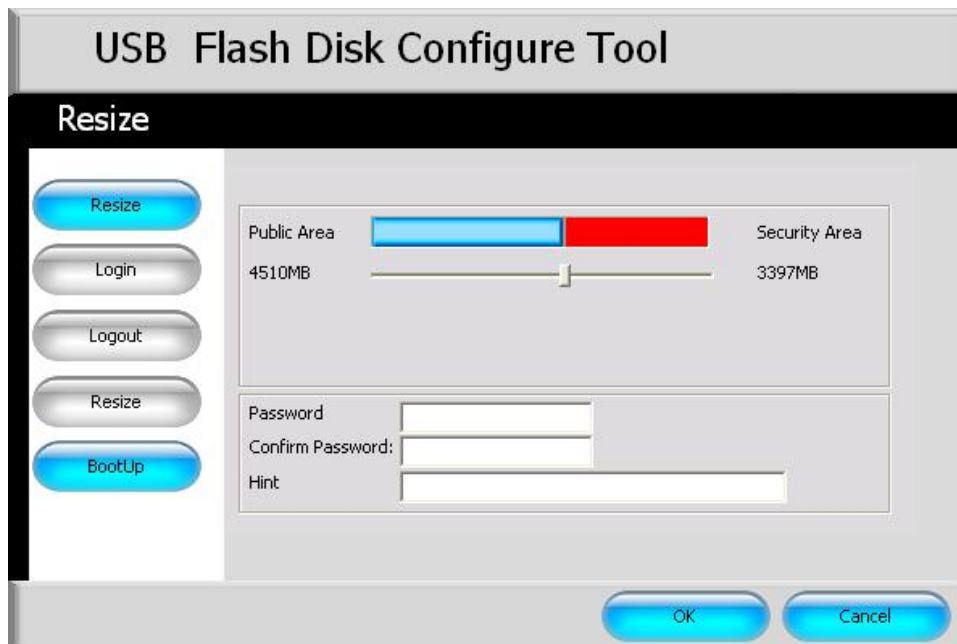

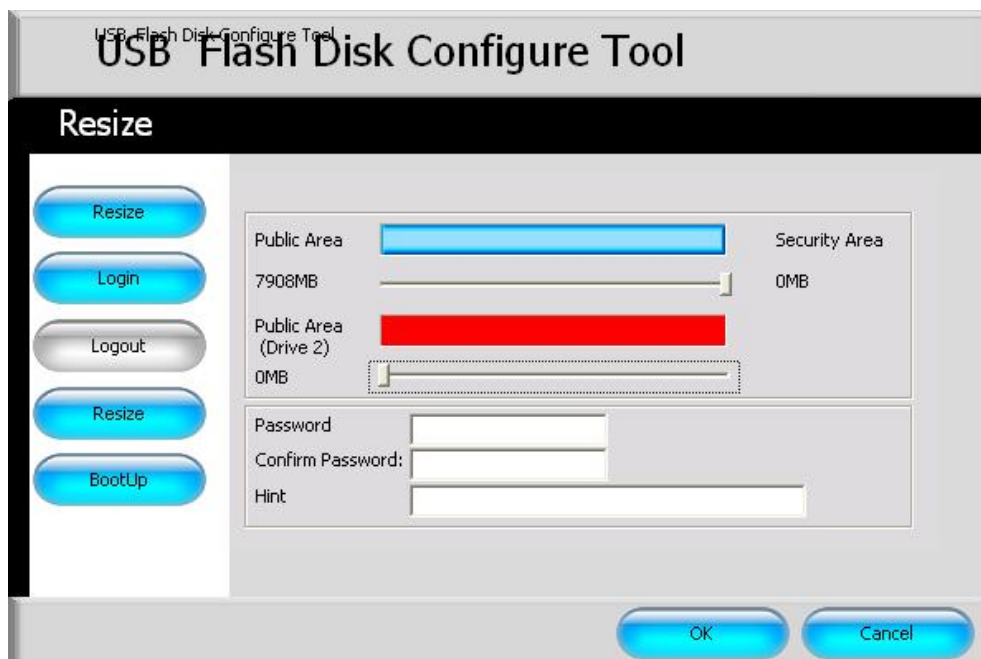


1.2 One Disk (1 Public Area + 1 Private Area)

“Public Area” & “Private Area”, and provide password of Private.




1.3 Two Disks (2 Public Area + 1 Private Area)


